## Welcome to our Inaugural Quarterly Newsletter:

### A time of Implementation and Growth

The past four years have been times of preparation, planning, and implementation. We have been hard at work behind the scenes, and every now and then popping up on social media. We are well on our way to being a well-established organization, and we have two of our three services up and running. To put it into perspective, here are some of the highlights of what we have been focused on and where we are now:

- 2020- Established as a non-profit society
- 2021 - Successful in our application to the CRA to be an approved Registered Charity
- 2022- Opened the Daycare Service - initially with 7 children. Now, we have 27 children being cared for in our center with the support and supervision of a team of 7 full time staff and 3 part time on call staff.
- 2023- Expanded our daycare service by adding a new multi-age program giving us space to care for children as young as 12 months old. This program opened Dec 01 and was full immediately.
- 2023/24- Focus on preparing to open the Maternity House.

From the time of our inception, we have experienced the generosity of heart of many and have been building community connections, partnerships, and professional relationships.

We have met with representatives from all levels of government and have been pleased with the warm reception and support for our mission and vision.

- ✦ Expand its capacity to serve more young women and infants.
- ✦ Strengthen collaborative relationships with community organizations.
- ✦ Secure ongoing funding to ensure sustainability.
- ✦ Increase public awareness and engage with all levels of government.
